FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

The past several months have been a meaningful time in the life of our church. The Lenten season prepared us to remember Christ's life, teachings, suffering, and death in a deeper way. Our Easter celebration was just that as we celebrated Christ's resurrection with praise and proclamation, joy and jubilation. As the season of Eastertide has continued, we've thought together about what Jesus' resurrection means for and the difference it makes in our lives and our life together.

In the midst of all this, we had a wonderful Revival Sunday with Dr. Roger Gilbert as our guest preacher. I know you enjoyed and appreciated his messages and were blessed by them.

Eastertide continues for two more Sundays in May. The last Sunday of Easter (May 12) is also Ascension Sunday, when we'll be thinking together about the significance of the risen Jesus' ascending into heaven to be seated at the Father's right hand. The following Sunday (May 19) will be Pentecost Sunday, when we reflect on the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the church in Acts 2. Another important opportunity this month will be on Big Wednesday, May 1. Realizing how difficult health care decisions can be when parents are aging (or for individuals who have no spouse or children), our own Bob Lee, retired attorney, will present some valuable information on legal matters such as living wills or advanced directives, healthcare power of attorney, power of attorney for financial and other matters, etc.

I hope you'll take advantage of this opportunity and give your children or other potential caregiver a special gift by addressing these matters ahead of time.


