## FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE...

Thanksgiving is past, Advent is upon us, and Christmas is following close behind!

Now Advent is not simply celebrating Christmas early. It's a season of penitence and preparation, of anticipation and expectation, as we prepare our hearts to celebrate the birth of our Lord Jesus, the Messiah. Advent gets us ready for Christmas. We think about how God broke into history, sending his Son to save us from our sins. We think about the preparations he made-some in miraculous ways, some through the ordinary events of history-and the promises he gave of salvation and deliverance. But we also look ahead to the fulfillment of the promise that Christ will return in glory to raise the dead, to judge the world, and to set everything right in new heavens and a new earth, where righteousness is at home. And as we look ahead, we prepare our hearts so that we may be ready when he comes.

With all that our culture bombards us in its secular, commercial celebration of the holidays, it's easy to lose sight of what Christmas is really all about. Advent helps us focus and stay focused, reminding us that these are holy days. It puts Bethlehem in the context of God's great eternal purpose of redemption, reminding us how God made promises and prepared the way, that the baby in the manger was God the Son in the flesh, who is King of Kings and Lord of Lords, who will come again to bring his kingdom in its fullness!

So as we move through this season Advent to Christmas and the of celebration of Christ's birth, don't get lost in the hustle and bustle. Stay focused on what we truly celebrate by taking time to worship, and by allowing that worship to direct your celebration.

We'll celebrate Christ's birth together with two special worship opportunities. The choir from Middle Swamp Baptist Church will join our choir on Sunday, December 15 at 3:00 to present the Christmas cantata, "Love Came Down at Christmas." Then on Christmas Eve at 5:30 p.m., we'll gather in the sanctuary for our Christmas Eve Candlelight Service of Lessons, Carols, and Communion. This is always a special time of worship, and I encourage you to make it a priority as we remember together how "the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld his glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth" (John 1:14).

On a different note, I want to commend our congregation for all the local mission efforts we participate in throughout the year and during the holiday season: the Food Bank and our food pantry distributions, benevolence ministries, Backpack Buddies, community involvement, the Angel Tree, the White Christmas food boxes, and much more.

December brings us the opportunity to offer support to global missions as well, and that is most appropriate. After all, Christmas is ultimately about Christ's mission! During December we will receive the CBF Global Missions Offering. Every dime of this offering goes to support the presence of CBF mission field personnel in the United States and around the world. We must always be attentive to our local mission needs, but we must also be supportive of global mission needs as well. I encourage you to pray for our missionaries and to give generously to this offering.

As we approach Christmas, let me say how much JoAnn and I appreciate your prayers, love. kindness, and encouragement. We are very thankful to be a part of the MBC family. We wish you a blessed Advent, a Christmas filled with the joy and peace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and a new year filled with the adventure of being on mission with him, following him as Lord!
